Dress Code Policy

The purpose of the Code of Conduct is to ensure a safe and orderly educational climate conducive to learning. Students are expected to demonstrate responsible behavior that does not interfere with the safety, well-being, or educational opportunities for themselves or others

Examples of items not allowed:

visible undergarments



any reference to pornography

any reference to drugs/alcohol/weapons



tube tops, sports bras, corsets/bustiers worn alone as tops



PYLUSD School Board Policy establishes that students shall wear appropriate clothing and footwear and groom themselves for school in a manner that does not offend the decency of, reflect negatively on, or detract from any phase of, the educational program. The administration and staff believe that dress affects the academic environment at school and, in some cases, can be disruptive to the learning environment. Therefore, the dress code applies at all times* to students while on campus or in attendance at any school event.

When fashion trends come about that compromise the learning environment or safety of our students, Administration reserves the right to adjust the dress code accordingly without prior notice.
