Tardiness - Message from Mr. Davis: Parents, being on time is a life skill that many of us struggle with. As one of my former bosses used to say "Early is on time, on time is late, and late is unacceptable." As a reminder, we began doing random tardy sweeps after returning from winter break. Several times per week, we are doing random tardy sweeps and finding numerous students who are not going to class on time. Each classroom has a tardy poster with the consequences for multiple tardies to each period. It is tradition that students get a fresh start at the beginning of each semester. You are encouraged to review student's attendance in Aeries and see their tardies, represented as a T on the attendance screen. We are seeing a lot of students late to class.
